Volunteer Projects for Home

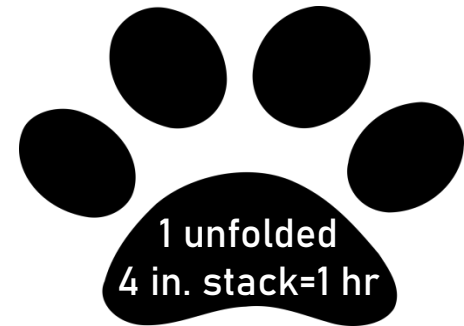
Newspaper

Instructions

1. Remove all ads and discard.
2. Unfold newspapers and separate full sheets from half sheets.
3. Neatly stack the newspapers into two piles.

Helpful Tip

- ✓ Fold piles in half when they're done to make them easier to carry!



No-Sew Blanket

Supplies

- 2 pieces of 27"x30" fleece
- Sharp scissors

Instructions

1. Layer both pieces of fleece.
2. Cutout 3"x3" squares off each corner.
3. Cut slits 1" wide & 3" deep into each side.
4. Tie all slits together till you're done!

Helpful Tips

- ✓ Use tape or water-soluble fabric pen to give yourself 'cut to' lines (doesn't have to be exact).
- ✓ Double tie each slit so they don't come apart when washed!



Catnip Ball

Supplies

- Material (size varies by number of toys making)
- Catnip
- Cotton balls
- Ribbon
- Sharp scissors

Instructions

1. Cutout 6" circle of material.
2. Put 1-2 cotton balls in middle of circle.
3. Sprinkle 1 tablespoon of catnip over cotton balls.
4. Bundle up and double tie with ribbon.

Safety Tip

- ✓ Do not use gift wrap curling ribbon as it can shred and cause cats to choke if ingested.



Dog Rope Toy

Supplies

- 18"x24" fleece or t-shirt
- Sharp scissors

Instructions

1. Cut fleece/t-shirt into 6 strips measuring 3"x24".
2. Knot all 6 strips together at one end and braid together using 2 strips per section.
3. Once braid almost reaches the ends of the fleece/fabric, knot strips together again.

Add Tennis Ball

1. Cut holes in opposite ends of tennis ball.
2. Thread 3 strips of fleece/fabric through tennis ball and knot each set of tails close to tennis ball to prevent it from slipping along your braid.
3. Braid each tail out 6" to 12" and continue knotting till finished.

Helpful Tip

- ✓ Braid your toys nice and tight so dogs can get more playtime out of them!



Foster Care Package

Supplies

Instructions

1. Place items for specific animal in a bag, basket, box, etc.-be as creative as you wish (grocery bags work too!).
2. Label what type of animal package is for if not visible (gift wrapped, sealed box, etc).

Examples

- For cat/kitten: bed/big towel, canned kitten/cat food, toys, comb, litter scooper.
- For dog/puppy: bed/big towel, canned puppy/dog food, toys, treats, comb/brush.
- For kitten/puppy being bottle fed: add milk replacement.



Verification Process

2. After hours, drop project in outdoor bin in front of main shelter and email completed form and snap of your creation to volunteer@cap4pets.org!
