Drop-Off / Pick-Up Arrangements

CAP Kids & Kritters Summer Camp Hours are 8 a.m. – noon. (CAP does not offer extended childcare options at this time.)

Children can begin to arrive at CAP Kids & Kritters Camps no earlier than 7:45 a.m. **All campers must be dropped off at side gate located on west side of the CAP Animal Shelter and signed in with the Kids & Kritters Camp staff.** Please do not drive up and let your child/children walk into the facility alone.

Campers will be ready to be picked up at side gate located on the west side of the CAP Animal Shelter at noon each day. Campers will be released only to those persons whom the parent or guardian has designated on the program registration form. These persons may be asked to show proper identification at the time of pick-up. **If you are late picking up your child, a late fee of \$1.00 per minute beginning at 12:10 p.m. will be charged and due at the time you pick up your child.** Your child/children need to be signed in and out by the parent/guardian or the persons who have been designated on this registration form. **Please do not leave without signing out your child(ren).**

Waiver of Liability , Permission Form Release of Images

- I am the legal guardian of the participant. I am of legal age and am freely signing this agreement on behalf of the participant. I understand that all participants including myself are expected to abide by all rules and guidelines established by Citizens for Animal Protection (CAP) during the camp.
- I understand that my child will be participating in activities at Citizens for Animal Protection (CAP) and that in the course of such activities the child will have direct contact with various animals such as walking dogs and feeding cats and rabbits.
- I further understand that while all precautions are taken to ensure participant safety, the behavior of animals is sometimes unpredictable and that animals are capable of inflicting serious personal injury. Knowing the risks of interacting with animals, on behalf of my child and myself, I agree to assume those risks and release, indemnify, and hold harmless CAP and/or any of its officers, directors, employees, agents, or contractors for any and all personal injury or property damages resulting from my child's participation in camp activities. I agree to hold Citizens for Animal Protection harmless for any and all claims for injuries, causes for action or liability related to use of all Citizens for Animal Protection facilities.
- I give CAP authority to seek emergency medical treatment for my child. I know of no medical or other condition that would prevent my child from participation in activities at CAP.
- I hereby grant permission to Citizens for Animal Protection (CAP) to take and use: photographs and/or digital images of me and of my child/children for use in brochures, news releases, educational materials and any other lawful purposes.
